Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Year 5 topic on 'Space' we have arranged a trip to the National Space Centre in Leicester. The visit will include exploring the hands-on interactive galleries and a one hour Planetarium Show.

This visit will take place on **Tuesday 28th June** and children will travel by coach. Children will leave school after registration and return late to school by **4:30pm**.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £23.00 per child towards the cost of the visit, which should be paid using ParentPay. You will also need to give your consent for your child to go on this visit by ticking the box on ParentPay. We regret that we may be obliged to cancel this visit if we do not receive sufficient financial support.

The children should wear their normal school uniform, suitable outdoor clothing appropriate for the weather on the day and a comfortable pair of shoes.

As we are away from school over the lunch period your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day. If you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this visit it must be ordered in advance and payment of £2.25 made using ParentPay (unless your child is entitled to Free School Meals). To order a school packed lunch please email your request to your child's class teacher so they are aware and can collect the lunch from the kitchen on the day of the trip.

In order for your child to take part in this visit please tick the consent box on ParentPay, no later than **Tuesday 14**th **June.** Before ticking the consent box it is important that you understand that.
