I know what peer-pressure is and how it can cause people to make unsafe choices

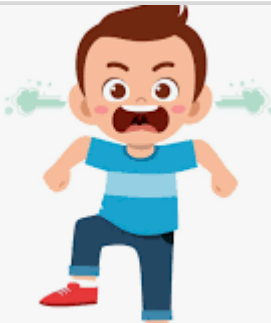


I know that families can have the same sex parents.

Key Vocabulary and Definitions

Peer-pressure	Influence from others to do something, whether it is right or wrong.
Influence	the power or invisible action of a thing or person that causes some kind of effect on another
Anger	a strong feeling caused when someone or something has done something wrong to you
Angry	feeling or showing anger
manage	to direct or control
Same sex	a sexual relationship between two men or between two women
Lesbian	a woman who is attracted to other women
Gay	a person who is physically attracted to people of the same sex Usually two men.
Family	all of the people related to you by blood or marriage
parent	a mother or a father
