Dear Parent/Carers.

Year 5 trip to Frogmore Paper Mill – Monday 6th December and Tuesday 7th December.

In support of our Year 5 topic on the Victorians, we have arranged a visit to Frogmore Paper Mill. During the visit the children will have the opportunity to participate in workshops based around Victorian industry, paper making and the history of the canal.

The visit will take place over two days, **Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th December** due to site only accommodating up to 45 children on each visit.

Coconut Class will visit on Monday 6th December.

Half of Monkey Puzzle Class will visit on Monday 6th December. *

Holly Class will visit on Tuesday 7th December.

****Monkey Puzzle Class parents and carers will be informed about their child's visit day via email.***

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at **8.50am** and we will return late to school by **3:40pm**, traffic permitting. We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£16** per child towards the cost of the visit. We regret that we may be obliged to cancel this visit if we do not receive sufficient financial support.

In order for your child to take part in this visit please tick the consent box on ParentPay. This needs to be done by **Monday 22nd November 2021**, at the latest.

As we are away from school over the lunch period your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day. If you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this visit it must be ordered in advance by emailing your child's class teacher by **Monday 22nd November**. They will then be able to collect it from the school kitchen on the day of the trip. This must be paid for via ParentPay (unless your child is entitled to Free School Meals).

Before ticking to give consent on ParentPay, it is important that you understand that,

1. While the supervisory adults in charge of the group will take all reasonable care of the young person, neither they, nor the Academy, can necessarily be held liable in respect of loss of or damage to the property or injury suffered by the young person arising out of the educational visit/journey, unless such loss, damage or injury results from the negligence of Goldington Green Academy, its employees or official volunteers, and
 2. That you read and understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.
