## Key Vocabulary and Definitions

In-app purchases	Buying goods or services within an application. Such as add-ons or in game currency.
river	a large natural stream of water that flows over land
lake	large body of water that is surrounded by land
water	the clear liquid that is in rain and that fills up rivers, lakes, and oceans
swim	an activity that involves moving through the water using your arms and legs
debt	what someone owes to someone else
Head injury	an injury to the scalp, skull, or brain.
casualty	a person who is hurt or killed during an accident, war, etc
Severe bleeding	Blood is pumping from the wound. The bleeding does not stop or slow down with pressure. Blood is quickly soaking through bandage after bandage
Minor burn	when something hot damages your skin
fracture	a break in the bone
seizure	when something unusual happens in your brain.
Heart attack	Something that happens when an artery suddenly becomes blocked
