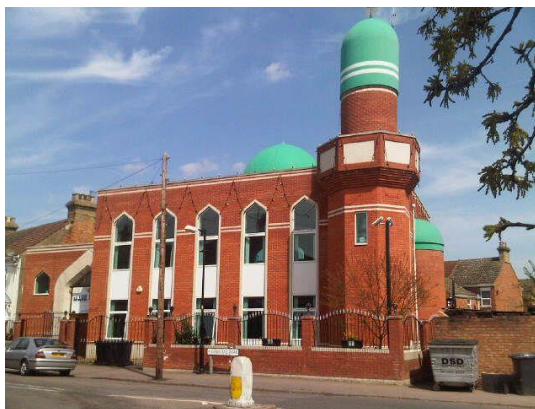

Why are we learning this?

To know about other faiths and to understand how others may choose to live their lives and the reasons behind it.

Why is it important?

So that we can ask questions and suggest answers about how we live can make a difference to others in our community.

What am I going to learn?

Raise questions and suggest answers about the value of submission and self-control to Muslims and whether there are benefits for people who are not Muslims.
Make links between the Muslim idea of living in harmony with the Creator and the need for all people to live in harmony with each other.

Know examples of worship in Islam and describe what they involve.
