



## Success Criteria for a Firework Poem

- I have used an interesting form for my poem.
- The style is distinctive and memorable.
- I used repetition or word play to effect.
- I thought about rhyme and sound patterns.
- I chose words carefully.
- I deliberately positioned words and phrases.
- I showed feelings and mood.
- I made a link between the poem and the title.
- I used metaphors.
- I used hyperbole.

A metaphor is a comparison between two things that aren't alike but do have something in common.

Hyperbole is an exaggeration used for emphasis or humour.



## Success Criteria for Performing a Poem

- I have used intonation to emphasise the punctuation and content of the poem.
- I have used expression to add detail and excitement for the listener.
- I have used gestures and body movement to convey the character(s).
- I have projected my voice so that people can hear me from the back of the hall.
- I have taken feedback from my teachers or peers and used it to make improvements to my performance.

## Success Criteria for a Deforestation Poem
