Key Vocabulary and Definitions

perpetrator	someone who has committed a crime
bystander	someone who happens to be there when something happens
Victim	someone who is hurt, injured, or killed by a person, group, or event
Enabler	to give means or power to; make able; allow
First aid	the initial, immediate help that is given to someone who suffers an injury or illness
Recovery position	Roll someone on to their side to keep their airway open
CPR	a method of reviving heart attack victims
Airway	passages from their nose and mouth down to their lungs
Breathing	is the process of taking air into and out of the lungs
Circulation	the flow of blood, oxygen and nutrients around your body via the circulatory system
Enterprise	a plan or project that is risky, bold, or difficult to carry out
earn	to receive as pay for work done
