Dear Parent/Carers

Year 1 Visit to Woburn Safari Park – Tuesday 8th June 2021

In Year 1 we are taking our children to Woburn Safari Park, as a wellbeing trip due to Covid. We consider that our children deserve this 'Wellbeing Trip' as a reward for their hard work during these challenging times through the pandemic. Throughout the visit the children will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities and appreciate being back into school and getting back to some normality.

The visit will take place on **Tuesday 8th June 2021**. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 9am and we will return to school by the end of the school day, traffic permitting. We are not asking parents for a contribution for this trip as it is classed as a wellbeing trip for our children and the school is paying for the trip. (Please log on to ParentPay in order to give permission for your child to go on this trip.)

The children should wear their normal school uniform and will need suitable outdoor clothing appropriate for the weather on the day and a comfortable pair of shoes.

As we are away from school over the lunch period your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day and bottles of drink (these must not be fizzy drinks). **If you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this visit it must be ordered in advance by emailing your child's class teacher. They will then be able to collect it from the school kitchen on the day of the trip.**

In order for your child to take part in this visit please tick the consent box on ParentPay, no later than **Friday 21st May 2021**. Before ticking the consent box it is important that you understand that,

1. While the supervisory adults in charge of the group will take all reasonable care of the young person, neither they, nor the Academy, can necessarily be held liable in respect of loss of or damage to the property or injury suffered by the young person arising out of the educational visit/journey, unless such loss, damage or injury results from the negligence of Goldington Green Academy, its employees or official volunteers, and
2. That you read and understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.
