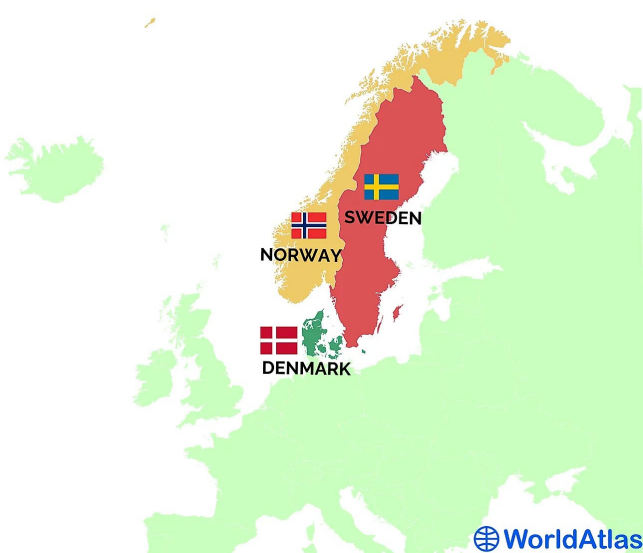
Key Vocabulary and definition

Scandinavia is a region in Northern Europe. It consists of the countries Norway, Sweden and Denmark.

Physical features: Norwegian Fjords, Northern Lights, Land of the midnight sun, Gulf of Bothnia, North Sea, Klaralven River

Capital cities: Norway = Oslo Sweden = Stockholm Denmark = Copenhagen

Major Cities Norway = Bergen, Alesund, Stavanger Sweden = Uppsala, Gothenburg Denmark = Aarhus, Odense
