Communication



Meetings & Communication

To be successful meetings need...

1. Rules
2. An agenda
3. Minutes taken
4. A Chairperson
5. A report back process
6. Action planning

Reporting back

- After going to a meeting, Councillors need to tell their class what happened - this is called **reporting back**.
- Reporting back is telling your classmates: -
 - *What was discussed at the meeting*
 - *What was decided*
 - *What is going to be done*
 - *What your classmates can do to help*
- Always have your own meeting notes, or the minutes from the meeting with you, to help you remember.
