

Why are we learning this?

To know the importance of showing love to each other.
To know that the Bible is an important book to Christians and has stories of showing love that can be compared to other stories of showing love in the world today.

Why is it important?

To help us understand how to live a good life and to take care of each other.
To know how Christians use the Bible to learn how to live their lives.

What am I going to learn?

To know what kind of world Jesus wanted?

To know about texts that come from a Gospel (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) in the Bible.

To be able to make links between the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of men'.

Know how Christians try to show love for all.

Is this different to how non-Christians show love?

Make links between the importance of love in Bible stories and life in the world today.

Why are we learning this?

Ask questions about what is worth celebrating and why.
